TRAVEL TO LUTTERWORTH UK AFTER THE MEETINGS IN HOLLAND

If travelling to the UK after Dr. Pidgeon has finished speaking at the meetings in Holland, please see the following flight and travel information in order that we might travel together and possibly share taxis.

The flight to aim for is:

Friday 6th October KLM Airlines - KL1431 leaving Schiphol AMS, Amsterdam at 16.35 (CEST) arriving at Birmingham International Airport at 16.50 (BST). Flight time 1 hour and 15 minutes - (note time zone difference) <https://www.schiphol.nl/en/>

If unable to book this flight, there are other budget airlines in operation flying to Birmingham International Airport including EasyJet (mostly direct flights) and Ryanair (normally via Dublin). Kayak and Opodo usually give the best deals.

Note:

- **Birmingham International Airport** is the closest airport to fly into. Onward travel by train to **Rugby Station** is the most straightforward mode of transport using a pre-booked taxi service Lutterworth from Rugby. See Taxis below.

- The actual train station connected to Birmingham Airport is called “**Birmingham International Station.**”
- The train journey from Birmingham International Airport to Rugby takes less than an hour.
