What is a nephesh? Is this the same as a soul?

"and the man became a living breathing creature."

"For the soul (nephesh) of the flesh *is* in the blood: he and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it *is* the blood of him *that* makes an atonement in the soul (nephesh)."

Vayiqra (Leviticus) 17:11

"For the breathing creature of the flesh *is* in the blood: he and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your breathing creature: for it *is* the blood of him *that* makes an atonement in the breathing creature."

Flesh בָּשָׂר H1320 Basar From H1319; *flesh* (from its *freshness*); by extension *body*, *person*; also (by euphemism) the *pudenda* of a man: - body, [fat, lean] flesh [-ed], kin, [man-] kind, + nakedness, self, skin.

Blood דָּם H1818 Dam From H1826 (compare H119); *blood* (as that which when shed causes *death*) of man or an animal; by analogy the *juice* of the grape; figuratively (especially in the plural) *bloodshed* (that is, *drops* of blood): - blood (-y, -guiltiness, [-thirsty]), + innocent.

Compare Soul vs Breathing Creature (nephesh)

The definition of soul:

 the immaterial and immortal essence, animating principle, or actuating cause of an individual life
the spiritual principle embodied in human beings, all rational and spiritual beings, or the universe

The concept of an immaterial and immortal soul – distinct from the body – did not appear in Judaism before the Babylonian exile but developed as a result of interaction with Persian and Hellenistic philosophies.

The definition of nephesh A breathing creature (nephesh) is life (chaya) giving by the names (neshemoth) of Yahuah in the blood (dam) of the flesh (basar).

What is a ruach? Is this the same as a spirit?

"And Yahuah said, My Ruach shall not always strive with man, for that he also *is* flesh: yet his days shall be a hundred and twenty years."

רוּחַ H7307 Ruach

From H7306; *wind*; by resemblance *breath*, that is, a sensible (or even violent) exhalation; figuratively *life, anger, unsubstantiality*, by extension a *region* of the sky; by resemblance *spirit*, but only of a rational being (including its expression and functions): - air, anger, blast, breath, X cool, courage, mind, X quarter, X side, spirit ([-ual]), tempest, X vain, ([whirl-]) wind (-y).

Πνέω G4154 pneu A primary word; to *breathe* hard, that is, *breeze*: - blow.

Compare Spirit vs. Ruach

The definition of spirit:

1 the principle of conscious life; the vital principle in humans, animating the body or mediating between body and soul.2 the incorporeal part of humans: present in spirit though absent in body.

The concept of spirit or ghost is a Sumerian concept; giving the ruach a personality.

The definition of ruach: The Ruach is giving by Yahuah is a breath or wind, which constitutes life and contains attributes like for example wisdom, knowledge, patience, etc.

Ra means "eyes are the head" or "the head are the eyes" or "Your own eyes" or "your own o insights". Evil means "your own eyes are leading"; or in other words "evil is your own insigths".

"Thus book has an interesting history and some corroboration from remnants found at Qumrun in the Dead Sea Scrolls.
